

2020 TBF OREGON TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

TBF Oregon Social Distancing guidelines while ashore and while underway:

1. Mask or buffs to be worn anytime you are ashore, when you are in a boat within 6' of your non-family member partner, and during the Weigh-In.
2. Do not form groups larger than 10 people.
3. Adhere to 6' distance from other groups.

Check-In/Registration/Drivers Meeting

1. Please mail in your registration which can be downloaded from our website <http://tbforegon.org/>. If you are not TBF Oregon members, then download and complete the membership forms as well. Please send all forms and a check at least one week prior to the event.
2. If you can't mail your registration at least one week prior to the event, then of the download registration and membership forms, complete and sign the forms and have everything. Big fish is an option and cash only.
3. **Both anglers are required to sign the liability statement on the entry form.**
4. While waiting for check-in do not form groups larger than 10. Groups need to stay at least 6' apart. Only one team member is needed to complete the check-in and registration process. Please form a line and maintain at least 6' away from the person ahead of you. You will be assigned a flight number. Each flight will contain no more than 5 boats and will be reversed for the second day of the weekend.
5. Please handle weigh in bags while wearing gloves. If you do not have gloves, TBF Oregon will provide you with a set to use.
6. The Drivers Meeting will be on the water. Please launch as soon as possible after check-in to avoid groups.
7. Blast off will be by flight number (5 boats spaced 10 minutes apart for departure and return). This is being done to hopefully limit the formation of groups greater than 10.

TBF Oregon Weigh-In and Wrap-Up:

1. Adhere to social distancing guidelines.
2. Tie up by flights, if safe to do so, a maximum of 10 boats can be tied up at any one time. Note that this may be adjusted based on the ramp being used and the amount of activity at the ramp. If possible, separate the boats by flight number, it will just make things flow faster and prevent groups of more than 10 forming.
3. Weigh-In will be conducted by flight number. Flight numbers will be reversed on day two of the weekend.
4. Five Weigh-In bags will be issued. Wearing of gloves by the person handling the bag is required.
5. Please mark your big fish, it will be weighed first.
6. After Weigh In, take your fish to your boat and give your bags to someone who is wearing gloves in the next flight number. Please do not try to weigh in until the flight ahead of you has completed their weigh in.
7. After weigh in, please clear the dock space for the next flight and return your fish at least one mile from the weigh in location.
8. Get your boat back on the trailer as soon as possible, maintain social distance guidelines while waiting for the wrap-up meeting.
9. We are new at this too, be patient, at least we are fishing again.
