

NEW CLUB INFORMATION

1. HOW CAN YOUR CLUB BECOME A TBF AFFILIATED CLUB?
 - a. It is easy, you just need 6 people and follow the information in the Club Membership Tab. TBF Oregon Can Assist with setting up a club.
2. WHAT ARE THE DUES/FEEES FOR TBF and TBF Oregon MEMBERSHIP
 - a. The minimum cost is \$70 (\$20 TBF Oregon and \$50 TBF/FLW) per person. Your new club may want to charge a local fee for operating expenses.
3. WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF TBF AFFILIATION?
 - a. See the Link for details
4. HOW DOES A CLUB SEND MEMBERS TO THE NATIONAL SEMI-FINALS?
 - a. Each club establishes it's on process for qualification.
 - b. A boater/non-boater pair are permitted to fish
 - c. There is an Entry Fee for the event which is held the first weekend of October
 - d. Oregon and Washington take turns hosting the event every other year.
5. HOW MANY FISHERMEN CAN A CLUB SEND TO THE NATIONAL SEMI-FINALS?
 - a. The number of qualifying pairs is determined by the number of primary/mother club members each club has. The minimum is one pair, the maximum is unlimited
 - b. One pair up to 19 members, then 2 pairs 20-29, 3 pairs 30-39, adding a pair for every ten members.
6. CAN A CLUB HAVE BASS NATION AND TBF AFFILIATION?
 - a. Absolutely, all it takes is for a minimum of 6 of your club members to make a TBF Club. You don't have to change your club name and you can fish your regular tournament schedule. There are no rules since the members own the club, not TBF or TBF Oregon
7. How can I join an existing TBF Club in Oregon?
